- Expanding our education outreach initiatives.



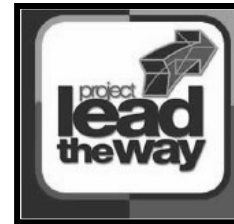
### Scholarship Accomplishments

- Increased our scholarship fund to its highest level ever over \$600K.
- Our Inaugural Scholars and Honors Gala raised \$51K!+ for expansion of our Scholarship Program
- Honored Murphy Tuomey with the establishment of a named scholarship – the *Murphy Tuomey/A. Morton Thomas & Associates Annual Scholarship*.
- Awarded 10 scholarships of \$1,500 each.
- Developed the framework to double our scholarship awards over the next 5 years.



## 2006 Education Accomplishments

- Sponsored a local university architectural student – Sarah Stein to the SAME/ASCE Leadership Conference.
- Sponsored two local high school students to the SAME Military Engineering Summer Camps.
- Conducted on-site visits at local regional construction projects for local high students.
- Continued involvement in "Project Lead The Way" (local high school program with an engineering focus).



## 2006 Program Accomplishments

- Hosted 12 programs of high interest to our members (e.g., military transformation, BRAC, Industry Day Forums, etc.).
- Provided conference support for the Tri-Services DC Region BRAC Industry Forum.
