### Young Member Washington Aqueduct Tour

SAME DC Post Young Members and Fellows were given a "behind the scenes" tour of the Washington Aqueduct, Dalecarlia Water Treatment Plant on December 13, 2011. The Dalecarlia Water Treatment Plant is one of two treatment plants operated by the Washington Aqueduct, a division of the Baltimore District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The Washington Aqueduct produces drinking water for approximately one million citizens in the area. The tour included a walk-through of production operations; the control room; and the water quality laboratory.

### Young Member and Board of Directors Holiday Social

Young Members were invited to come network with the Board of Directors and its associated Fellows prior to our annual Holiday Event. This event gave Young Members the opportunity to learn about leadership opportunities in the Post and get to know their Board of Directors.

### Holiday Party

SAME DC Post members and colleagues gathered at the Army Navy Club on December 7th to celebrate the holidays and the closing of another memorable year. Representatives from the Armed Services branches chose one individual from their branch to recognize for their service. In honor of their service, the DC Post contributed \$1,500 to the Wounded Warrior Fund.

### Future Federal Budget Outlook Lunch Program

The DC Post gathered on February 23 for a luncheon program featuring a presentation on the federal government's future budget outlook. Mr. Lucian L. Niemeyer, Deputy Staff Director for the Minority Committee on Armed Services, United States Senate, allowed attendees to choose from a list of budget-related topics which were of most interest, ranging from BRAC, to Guam, to DoDEA's long term initiative to improve schools on military bases.

### Smart Grid and Energy Security Workshop

Since power grid resiliency and energy security has become a high priority within Department of Homeland Security and the U.S. Department of Defense, the DC Post held an educational workshop on March

22nd prior to the luncheon where attendees could glean key insights into developing and implementing an energy security strategy from leading industry experts. Speakers included Dr. Dorothy Robyn, Deputy Under Secretary of Installations and Environment, Office of the Secretary of Defense; b Director, Interagency Programs Office, Science & Technology Directorate, U.S. Department of Homeland Security; and Paul Bollinger, Director of Government Solutions for Boeing Energy.

On March 22nd the SAME DC Post hosted a luncheon program to discuss the U.S. Army's Energy Initiatives. Our speaker, LTC Kevin J Lovell, PMP, is an Engineer and Installation Analyst for the Office of the Secretary of the Army, Office of Business Transformation Directorate of Business Operations. LTC Lovell discussed how the Energy Initiatives Office (EIO) Task Force will provide expertise to Army installations currently pursuing renewable energy infrastructure with a focus on working with the private sector to execute large-scale renewable energy projects by streamlining existing acquisition processes.

# SAME BOOTH AT THE USA S&E FESTIVAL DRAWS CROWDS

WOW! What an amazing turnout for the 2nd Annual USA Science and Engineering Festival received. The expo took place at the Washington Convention Center on April 28th and 29th. Prior to the Festival, it was billed as “the largest celebration of science in the USA”, and they pulled it off. The entire weekend of activities inspired thousands of people of all ages to explore careers in STEM! The estimated number of participants is over 150,000!

As a supporter of STEM initiatives engaging young minds, SAME National and the DC Post sponsored a booth at the USA Science and Engineering Festival. We were one of over 3,000 exhibitors and 100 stage shows featuring celebrities such as Bill Nye the Science Guy, Jamie Hyneman and Adam Savage of the MythBusters, and Mayim Bialik from Big Bang Theory along with a handful of Nobel Prize winners such as Carol Greider and Carl Wieman. With such enticing competition, we were thrilled to capture the interest of such a large number of students and parents alike. SAME volunteers were busy educating and entertaining attendees from open to close both days.



SAME’s booth showcased a working lock and dam model borrowed from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers St. Louis District which demonstrated the size of barges, the ability to move cargo up and down stream with water and gravity alone, and allowed attendees to work the valves and gates themselves. Our other exhibit was a transportation project simulator from Autodesk. Designed from the modeling developed by Parson Brinckerhoff of their San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge

project, the Autodesk simulator permitted children to “drive” on the new suspension bridge similar to a virtual fly-through of a new building. The hands-on, interactive exhibits educated children of all ages.

Many thanks go to our volunteers who ensured SAME was well represented and who communicated the mission of our Society to this very large audience.
